Manufacturing Month October, 2017

- WHEREAS Manufacturing makes a significant contribution to British Columbia's economy and the prosperity of its citizens; and
- WHEREAS Surrey is home to over 650 manufacturers with many leading innovation in sectors such as fabricated metal products, food manufacturing and machinery; and
- WHEREAS In British Columbia manufacturing is the third largest contributor to the provincial economy generating \$45.8 billion in value-added output equivalent to 7.2% of all economic activity in BC; and
- WHEREAS Manufacturing provides well-paying, high-skilled employment opportunities to 170,000 people across the Province with wages that are nearly 15.5% higher than the provincial average; and
- WHERAS Canadian Manufacturing & Exporters (CME) and partner organizations are presenting an intense calendar of events, workshops and 30 youth plant tours through the month of October to heighten the profile of manufacturing and reinforce that manufacturing professions and skilled trade occupations are inspiring and rewarding careers;
